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Christmas Twirly Ornament Tutorial

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Paper: 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper of your choice

Tools: Stampin' Trimmer, 1/8" Hole Punch, Linen Thread (or thin ribbon of your choice, I used Linen Thread, 1/8" Real Red Ribbon, and the Thick Bakers Twine

Non-Stampin Up Products: 1/2" Bead

Measurements for the Large, Medium, and Small Ornaments:

Large - 12 each of 12" X 1" DSP

Medium - 12 each of 9" X 3/4" DSP

Small - 12 each of 6" X 1/2" DSP

Cut all DSP to the strip sizes listed above, fold in half, and glue the pieces together

Punch a 1/8" hole on both sides about 1/4" from the edge of the DSP

Cut a piece of twine, etc. at approximately 16", tie a knot large enough to hold in your 1/2" bead.

Thread the DSP pieces using the holes we punch on the side alternating colors

Next, thread through the top of the strips, beginning with the strip at the bottom

Add a bead at the top, pull the twine tight to create the shape you like, the tighter the squattier the ornament, the looser, the more twirly and flowy the ornament. Tie a knot and enjoy!
