



Tissue Box Get Well Card

Card Details:

Grapefruit Grove Cardstock: 5-1/2 X 8-1/2, scored at 4-1/4", 3-1/2" X 5" (tissue box), scored on the 5" side at 1/2", 2", 3", & 4-1/2"

Share What You Love DSP: 2-3/4" X 5-3/8" front top layer

Mint Macaron / Rich Razzleberry Cardstock: 3" X 5-1/2" top layer, scraps for sentiment layer

Whisper White Cardstock: 4" X 5-1/4" for the inside panel, scraps for sentiment layer

-Share What You Love Stamp Set

-Humming Along Stamp Set

-Grapefruit Grove Classic Ink Pad

-Rich Razzleberry Classic Ink Pad

-Share What You Love Artisan Pearls

-Story Label Punch (available while supplies last)

-Classic Label Punch (for top of tissue box)

-Dimensionals

-Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive

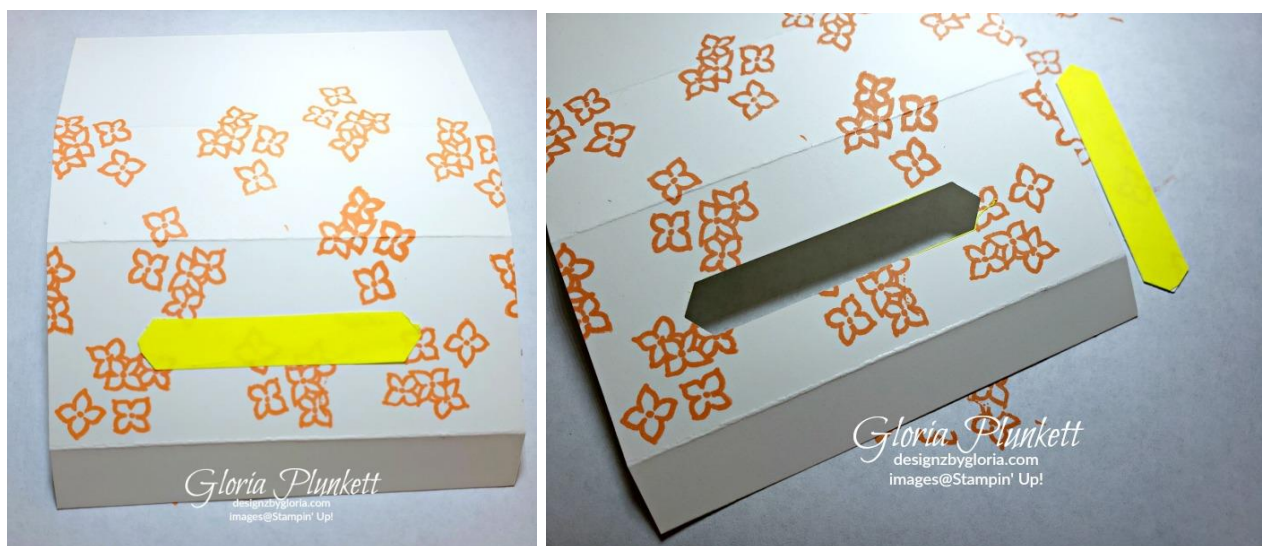
-Tear-n-Tape

Cut your cardstock as indicated in the measurements above. Score the 3 ½" X 5" piece of cardstock on the 5" side at ½", 2", 3", & 4-1/2". If you want your tissue box to have some images (I added flowers to mind-see photo), now is the time to do it.

TIP: To create a frame around the Story Label punched get well sentiment, I stamped the sentiment on a piece of Whisper White cardstock, then punch the sentiment, next using a piece of sticky paper, I reinserted the punched sentiment back into the punch ensuring I it was centered, I punched another piece out of the sentiment as shown on the photo above. Walla, you have a perfectly matched layer. Another option is to punch your layered piece, cut it down the middle, and this will also give you a layered look for your sentiment, but you may have a bit of a gap where you cut the cardstock in half.



Now back to the tissue box, as mentioned I stamped my box with some cute flowers from the Love What You Do Stamp Set in Grapefruit Grove Classic Ink. I cut out a piece of sticky paper using the Classic Label Punch and centered the piece on top of the tissue box to help me ensure it was perfectly centered. I then used the punch to cut out the hole. See photo below.



If you are using a darker colored cardstock like I did in the photo of my card, I like to insert a piece of Whisper White Cardstock in the inside to write my message/stamp a sentiment. Be sure if you plan to do this you do it "before" you start adding the tissue box. 😊 When I took the photos for this tutorial, I changed up to Thick Whisper White Cardstock for my card base, so I didn't need to add an additional Piece of Whisper White cardstock.

Next I adhered some Tear-N-Tape to the tissue box as shown in the photo below and close the card to ensure you have good clearance.



Now adhere another piece of Tear-n-Tape to the upper portion of the box which will butt up to the piece of card you just adhered to create your box. See photo below.



You will fold the box as shown in the photo below and you can either add additional Tear-n-Tape to the bottom of the box or use some Multipurpose Adhesive Glue like I did in this photo.



Finally, cut a piece of tissue in half, and tuck it into the box as shown, and pull up through the top.



And you're done.
