



Potted Plant Card Tutorial

Card Details:

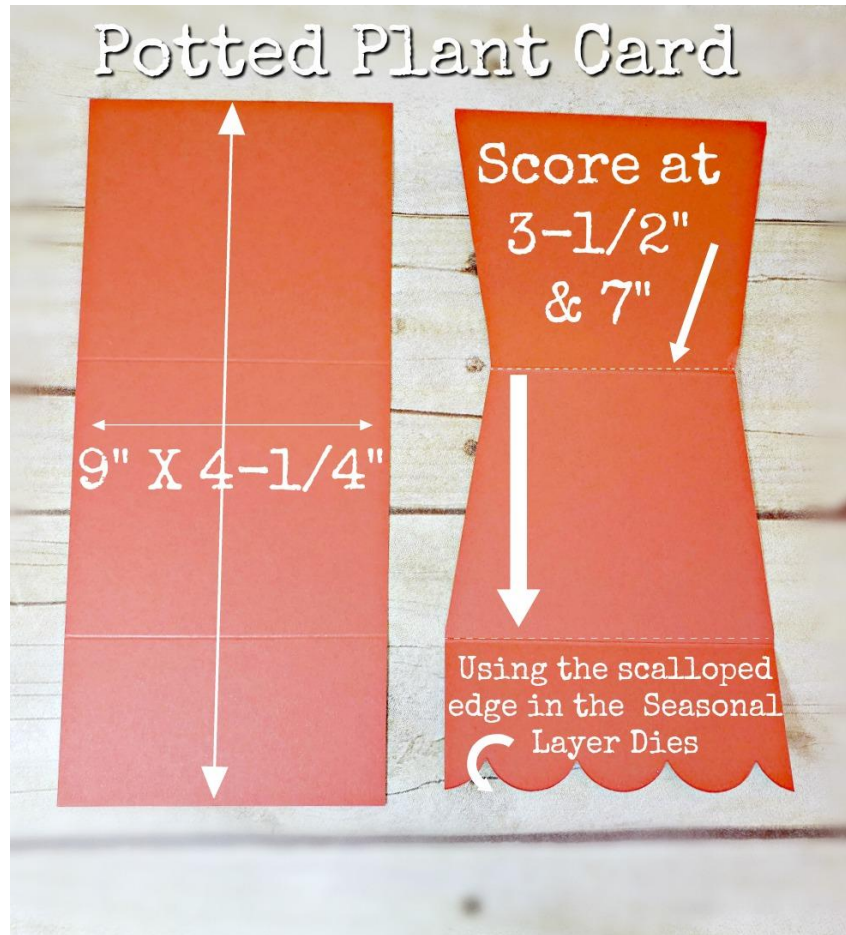
Cajun Craze Cardstock: 4-1/4" X 9", scored at 3-1/2, and 7", and 3-3/4" X 5-1/4" for the Insert

Very Vanilla Cardstock: 3-1/2" X 5 for the Insert, and 2-1/2" X 8-1/4" for stamping floral images

Pineapple Punch Cardstock: 3-4" for flourish die cut pieces

Granny Apple Green Cardstock: 2" X 4" for leaves

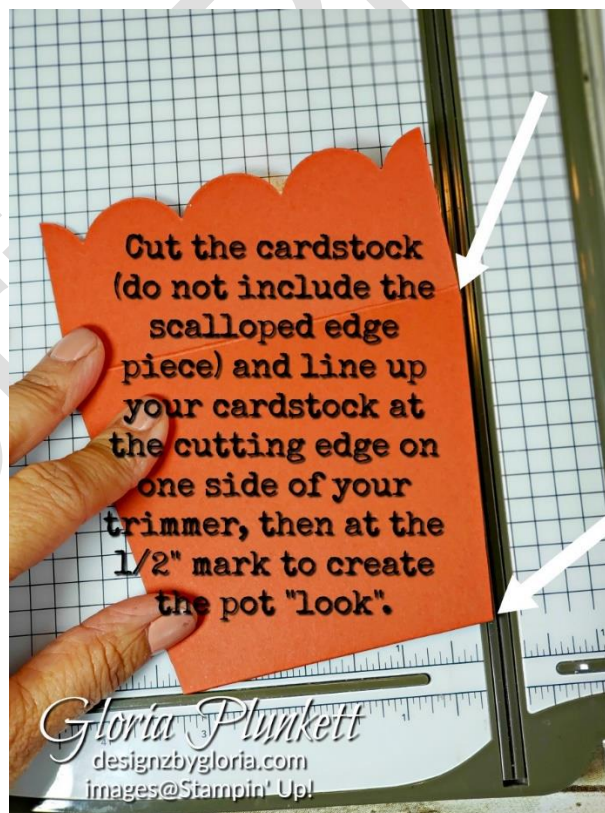
Pop of Petal Stamp Set, Flourishing Phrases Stamp Set, Gorgeous Grape, and Melon Mambo Classic Ink, Memento Black, 3/8" Crumb Cake Classic Weave Ribbon, Glitter Enamel Dots, Dimensionals, SNAIL Adhesive, Flourish Dies, Four-Petal Flower Punch, Seasonal Layers Thinlit Dies



Cut and score your cardstock at indicates above. Scallop the 2" edge of the cardstock (as shown in the above photo) with the Seasonal Layers Die



**Cut your insert pieces as shown in the measurements above.
Adhere the Vanilla over the Cajun Craze Cardstock.**



Now align your piece of cardstock as shown in the photo above, flip up the scalloped piece so you don't cut into it. Align one edge of the "pot" right at the cutting edge on the Trimmer, then place the bottom piece of the cardstock at the $\frac{1}{2}$ " mark and cut, you will end up cutting a small triangular piece off each side to create the pot.

Before I folded down the scalloped edge, I added dimensionals and then sealed it to the pot. Next, I tied the $\frac{3}{8}$ " Crumb Cake Classic Weave Ribbon to the center of the scalloped edge piece to keep my card closed. I didn't want to add any type of adhesive to the sides of the pot because it could make your insert "stick" as you push in and pull out.



Next, stamp and cut all the floral images and leaves you think you will like on your card. Remember you need to fit the whole thing in a standard A4 envelope so try not to go over the edge on the sides, and don't make it taller than 5-1/2". You're done! 😊
